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Day 9: Sahara Desert to Skoura via Todra Gorges



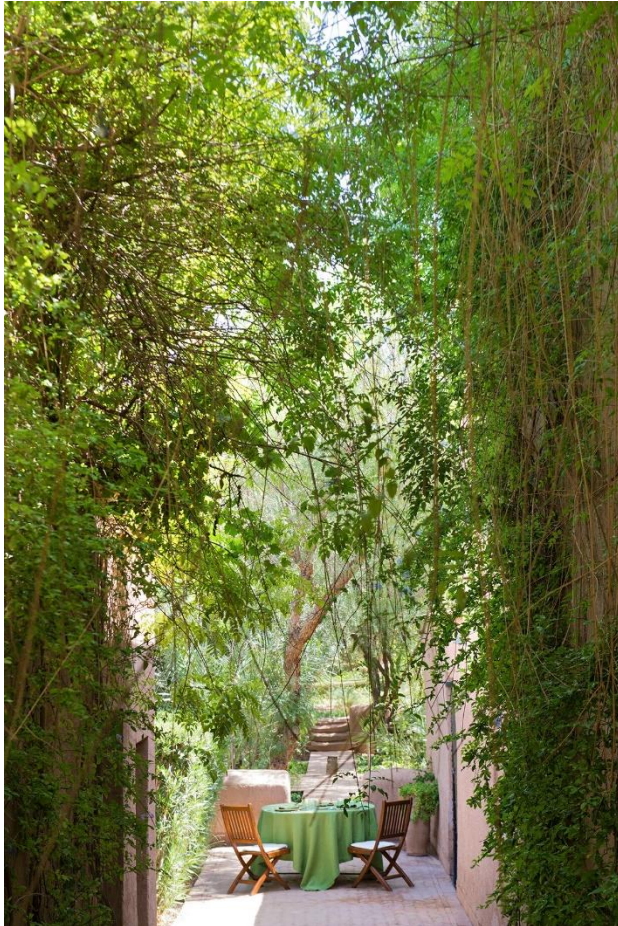

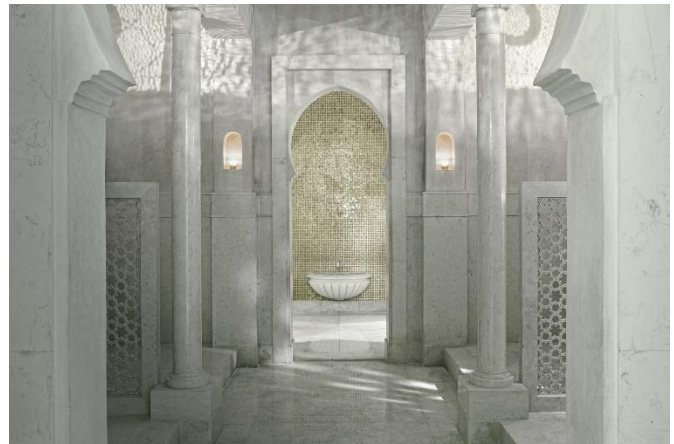


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Day 12: Guided Tour of Marrakech & Luxury Hammam at Royal Mansour:
